Leisure Services

Sanitation Department

- You will be able to ask questions and obtain a better understanding of the roles and responsibilities, including how neighborhoods can engage with the various areas.
 - You will also be provided a listing of online resources available to neighborhoods and the public.
 - Wrap up and evaluation of the class concepts and implementation.
