### Overview

The City Services 3 will be an interactive experience with city officials. There will be five segments to this program:

- A brief introduction of the evening and our guests.

You will be able to ask questions and obtain a better understanding of the roles and responsibilities, including how neighborhoods can engage with and/or assist the various areas.
- In addition, you will have an opportunity for roundtable discussions with the three Codes Compliance Assistance supervisors.
- Students will also learn about the City's comprehensive 10 year plan to address housing affordability.
- Wrap up and evaluation of the class concepts and implementation.
