### Overview

The City Services 4 will be an interactive experience with city officials. There will be four segments to this program:

- A brief introduction of the evening and our guests.
- Students will learn about the services and resources available from the Public Works Administration. Public Works consists of the Departments of Water Resources; Engineering; Stormwater, Pavement and Traffic Operations; and Fleet Management. You will be able to ask questions and obtain a better understanding of the roles and responsibilities, including how neighborhoods can engage with and/or assist the various areas.
- In addition, the Transportation and Parking Management Department will provide an overview of Complete Streets effort to encourage streets that are safe and convenient for all users of the roadway, including persons walking, persons riding bicycles, motorists, persons with disabilities, users and operators of public transit, seniors, children, and movers of commercial goods.
- Wrap up and evaluation of the class concepts and implementation.
